Spread the Word - someone from CLEAR can come present to your group, congregation or sunday school class to inform and inspire action, sharing about the status of the crisis and the justice work being done. Just ask us!



Collect & Donate – Current needs include gently used or new **rolling luggage** for those moving and leaving the country, **Visa/MC/Gas gift cards** for immediate needs of families of those taken, **new small stuffies/fidget toys/coloring kits** for children waiting with families at appts, **cases of water** for those waiting & serving outside.

Create & Assemble - **Whistle Kits & Know Your Rights information** to be distributed to vulnerable & affected communities. Assemble yourself, or get all the supplies and host a party! Details here: tinyurl.com/vuwhistlekits



Provide Food - Sign up to **deliver breakfast or lunch** to the Field Office for volunteers and those coming for appointments. www.giveinkind.com/inkinds/COM9J6A/fo-meal-train-and-food-donations-la-colectiva-ntx



Keep Vigil with us – **Attend CLEAR Prayer Vigils** any time you can Mondays, 8-10AM out front of the ICE Field Office on Stemmons service road – all/no faiths welcome. See cleardfw.org for detailed info.



Courthouse Presence – Volunteers perform hall monitoring, waiting room hospitality, accompaniment, or courtroom observation. Shifts M-Fs at immigration court downtown. Must be trained by Vecinos Unidos DFW.

Professional Assistance - Legal, medical, & mental health professionals willing to offer pro bono services are needed!



Field Office Support – Volunteers serve outside under tents to direct folks and provide important information to those going in for appointments. Shifts M-Sa behind ICE Field Office. Must be trained by La Colectiva NTX.

Unglamorous things you already know to do, that should not be underestimated:

- CALL your representatives repeatedly - 5calls.org can be helpful
- PRAY - yes, this has transformative power; yes, this matters!
- STAY INFORMED - follow orgs like Vecinos Unidos, La Colectiva, El Movimiento, & CLEAR on socials
- SHARE - repost as you can, tell others, keep conversations going
- SHOW UP when organizers call for it. Rallies, Press Conferences, Trainings. Presence matters. Witness & learn.

IMPORTANT NOTE: Our focus should be serving the community organizers for the good of our marginalized neighbors. Our positioning is to follow their lead, listen to and serve the needs they ask for, using any privilege we have for their benefit. We must regularly take time to reflect on our motives, attitudes and position in helping. Wanting to feel useful and good about our actions is understandable and indeed may be a gift we receive from the work, but it should not be our main motive. With a gentle (and regular) rearrangement of that mindset, we can proceed to do this important work.
